# GREATER ORLANDO ASIAN AMERICAN BAR ASSOCIATION FIRST ANNUAL SCHOLARSHIP

### **Purpose**

The Greater Orlando Asian American Bar Association ("GOAABA") created the Annual Scholarship to recognize the outstanding law student who has the potential to be a future leader in the legal profession in the Greater Orlando community. The scholarship winner will be announced in June 2021 with presentation of the \$1,000.00 award at GOAABA's Installation July 2021.

## **Eligibility and Selection Criteria**

The GOAABA Scholarship is open to all current law students currently enrolled in a Florida law school who intend to practice law in the Greater Orlando community after graduation.

The key selection criteria include:

- Intent to practice in the legal profession in the Greater Orlando community in Florida;
- Demonstrated leadership in the Asian Pacific American community and/or community service commitment in general;
- Demonstrated service commitment to the Asian Pacific American community and/or in general;
- Potential for leadership in the legal profession; and
- Demonstrated excellence and achievement in law school, including academic and extracurricular.

Other factors the Selection Committee may consider include financial need, overcoming any personal hardships or challenges, and availability to attend GOAABA's Installation in July, 2021.

The GOAABA Scholarship finalists will be selected and notified of their interview slot in May 2021.
